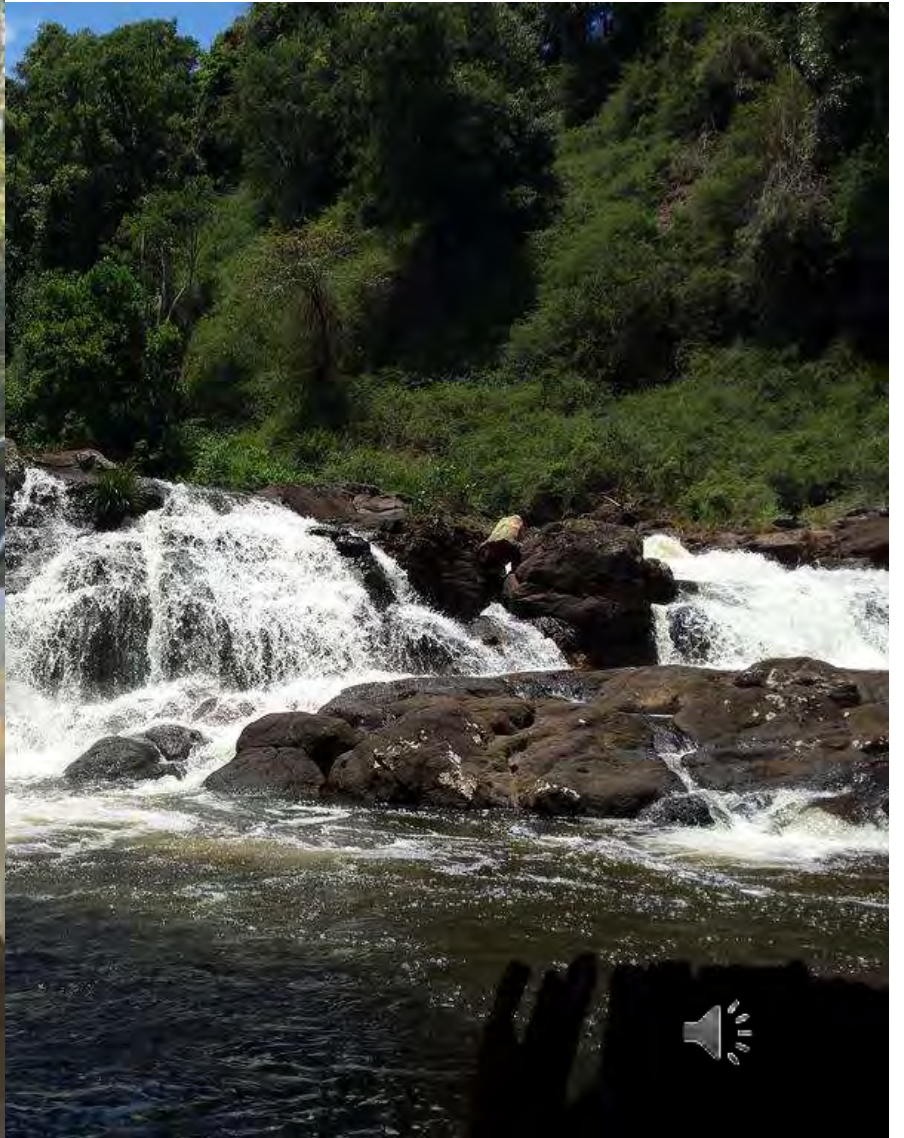

Key elements to achieve good ESC

1. Good ESC Plan
2. Competent contractor
3. Adequate budget and program
4. Regulator that will enforce compliance

Need all 4 for success!!



Creating a culture where these elements will thrive

Behaviour Management

1. Set clear expectations
2. Provide industry with tools/training necessary for success
3. Apply consequences



Setting expectations

- Long term: Legislation, policy, guidelines
- Short term: Approval conditions
